**WARMI JEWELS COWL**

**SKILL LEVEL**  
Intermediate

**SIZES**  
One size

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

6.5" (16.5 cm) high x 22" (56 cm) circumference

**MATERIALS**

2 Hanks AMANO WARMI (100gr), #6000 White Rose (MC); 1 hank each: #6002 Toasted Coffee (CC1), #6003 Quinoa (CC2), #6004 Pepper Red (CC3), #6009 Blueberry (CC4), #6008 Orchid (CC5), #6007 Olive Green (CC6), #6012 Chirimoya green (CC7).

OR

2 Hanks AMANO WARMI (100gr), #6000 White Rose (MC); 1 hank contrasting color of choice (CC), 16" Length circular knitting needle, size 7 (4.5 mm)

OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

Tapestry needle  
Stitch marker

**GAUGE**

22 sts = 4" (10.2 cm); 26 rows = 4" (10.2 cm) in St st

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

**NOTE**

The cowl is cozy warm double thick when worn. It is worked in the round as a tube. The cast on and bound off edges are sewn together to create the circular cowl.

**COWL**

Using MC, cast on 72 sts. Join, mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up.

**Rnd 1:** Knit.

**Rnd 2:** Purl.

**Rnd 3:** Knit.

**Rnds 4 - 8:** Work chart 1, with MC (background) and CC2 diamond motif.

**Rnds 9 & 10:** With MC, knit.

**Rnd 11:** With MC, purl.

**Rnd 12:** With MC, knit.

**Rnds 13 - 17:** Work chart 2, with MC (background) and CC4 diamond motif.

**Rnds 18 & 19:** With MC, knit.

Rep rows 2 to 19, eight times more, using the contrast colors in the following order: CC7, CC3, CC1, CC5, CC2, CC6, CC7, CC4, CC3, CC1, CC5, CC2, CC7, CC6, CC3, CC4.

**Next Rnd:** With MC, purl.

Bind off knit wise.

**FINISHING**

Turn piece inside out and weave in loose threads with tapestry needle. Turn piece to right side, and sew one end of the tube to the other, making sure to match up seam to seam.

Block as desired.

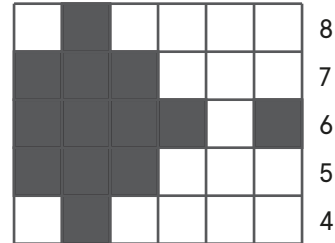

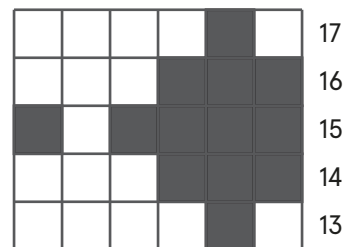

## ABBREVIATIONS &amp; TERMS

**beg:** beginning  
**BO:** bind off  
**CO:** cast on  
**cn:** cable needle  
**dec:** decrease  
**dpn:** double pointed needles  
**K:** knit  
**k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s)  
**k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together  
**k3tog:** Knit 3 stitches together  
**LH:** left hand  
**M1:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1L:** Work as for M1.  
**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1R:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).  
**p:** purl  
**PM:** place marker  
**psso:** pass slip stitch over knit stitch  
**p1d:** purl 1 st by going under the stitch below and working through both sts.  
**p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together  
**rep:** repeat  
**RH:** right hand  
**rnd(s):** round(s)  
**RS:** right side  
**sl:** slip  
**sl2tog-k1-psso:** Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.  
**SM:** slip marker  
**ssk:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.  
**sssk:** Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.  
**st(s):** stitch(es)  
**TBL:** through back loop(s)  
**tog:** together  
**WS:** wrong side  
**wyib:** with yarn in back  
**wyif:** with yarn in front  
**yo:** yarn over  
**end on WS:** end having just completed a Wrong Side row.  
**end on RS:** end having just completed a Right Side row.  
**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round

on a circular needle.

**Reverse St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

**K1, p1 Rib:** Knit 1 st, purl 1 st.

**3 Needle Bind Off:** With RS together, hold in one hand two needles with the same number of sts on each. with third needle, knit tog 1 st from each needle, \*knit tog one st from each needle, pass first st over second to bind off, repeat from \*to last st.
