## Adelpha cowl

| <p><b>MATERIALS</b><br/>2 Hanks AMANO AYNI (50g per ball), #5002 Paprika<br/>16" (40 cm) circular knitting needle, size 3 (3.25 mm) OR SIE TO OBTAIN GAUGE<br/>16" (40 cm) circular knitting needle, size 6 (4mm)<br/>Stitch marker<br/>Tapestry needle</p>                       |                                  |   |
| <p><b>GAUGE</b><br/>25 sts / 34 rnds= 4" (10.2cm) in Stockinette st with smaller needle<br/>23 sts / 40 rnds= 4" (10.2cm) in X Texture st with smaller needle<br/>17.5 sts / 33.5 rnds= 4" (10.2cm) in Lace st with smaller needle<br/>TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE</p> |                                  |   |

**NOTE**

Cowl is worked top-down in the round. The circumference at the top of the cowl is smaller than at the bottom because each stitch pattern used (Stockinette, X Texture, and Lace) creates different gauges (using the same needle.) There is one round in which shaping occurs (between the Stockinette and X Texture sections), but only two stitches are added. A larger needle is used for the bottom garter stitch edge to maintain gauge with the lace section.

**STITCH GLOSSARY**

**Sk2p:** Slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over (2 stitches decreased)

**X TEXTURE STITCH PATTERN**

Multiple of 6 stitches

**Rnds 1 and 3:** \*K3, p1, k1, p1; repeat from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** \*K4, p1, k1; repeat from \* to end.

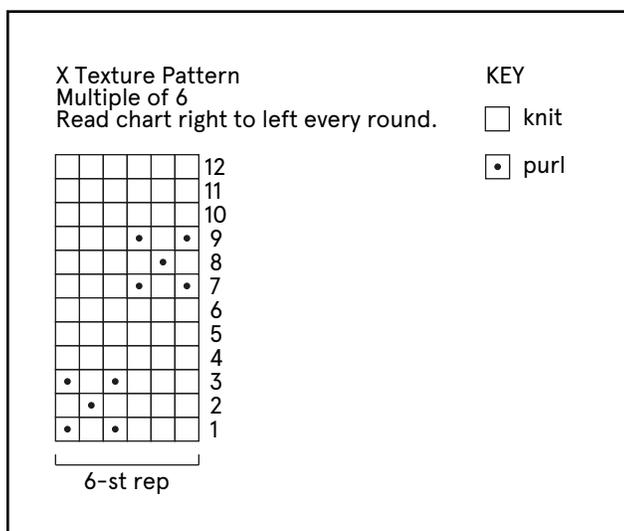
**Rnds 4-6:** Knit.

**Rnds 7 and 9:** \*P1, k1, p1, k3; repeat from \* to end.

**Rnd 8:** \*K1, p1, k4; repeat from \* to end.

**Rnds 10-12:** Knit.

Repeat Rnds 1-12 for pattern.

**LACE PATTERN**

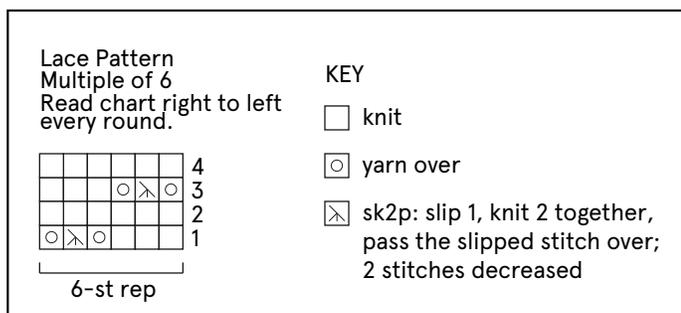
Multiple of 6 stitches

**Rnd 1:** \*K3, yo, sk2p, yo; repeat from \* to end.

**Rnds 2 and 4:** Knit.

**Rnd 3:** \*Yo, sk2p, yo, k3; repeat from \* to end.

Repeat Rnds 1-4 for pattern.

**DIRECTIONS****Top Edge**

With smaller needle, CO 112 sts. Place marker and join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

**Rnd 1:** Purl.

**Rnd 2:** Knit.

Repeat Rnds 1-2 four more times for garter edge. 10 rnds worked, 5 garter ridges. Measures about ¾" (2 cm) from CO.

**Stockinette Section**

Knit every rnd until piece measures 5¾" (14.5 cm) from CO.

**Inc Rnd:** M1, k56, M1, knit to end. 2 stitches increased. 114 sts.

**X Texture Section**

Work Rnds 1-12 of X Texture Stitch Pattern 5 times working 6-stitch pattern repeat 19 times each rnd. Piece measures about 11¾" (30 cm) from CO.

**Lace Section**

Work Rnds 1-4 of Lace Pattern 11 times, working 6-stitch pattern repeat 19 times each rnd. Then repeat Rnds 1-2 of Lace Pattern once more. Piece measures about 17¼" (44 cm) from CO.

**Bottom Edge**

Switch to larger needle.

**Rnd 1:** Purl.

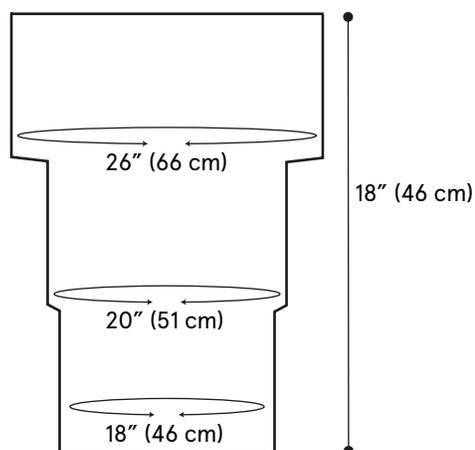
**Rnd 2:** Knit.

Repeat Rnds 1-2 for garter edge 3 more times. Purl 1 rnd. 9 garter rnds worked, 5 garter ridges. Piece measures about 18" (46 cm) from CO.

BO all stitches loosely.

**FINISHING:**

Weave in ends and block.

## ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**beg:** beginning  
**BO:** bind off  
**CO:** cast on  
**cn:** cable needle  
**dec:** decrease  
**dpn:** double pointed needles  
**K:** knit  
**k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s)  
**k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together  
**k3tog:** Knit 3 stitches together  
**LH:** left hand  
**M1:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1L:** Work as for M1.  
**M1p:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1R:** Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).  
**p:** purl  
**PM:** place marker  
**pssso:** pass slip stitch over knit stitch  
**p1d:** purl 1 st by going under the stitch below and working through both sts.  
**p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together  
**rep:** repeat  
**RH:** right hand  
**rnd(s):** round(s)  
**RS:** right side  
**sl:** slip  
**sl2tog-k1-pssso:** Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.  
**SM:** slip marker  
**ssk:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.  
**sssk:** Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.  
**st(s):** stitch(es)  
**TBL:** through back loop(s)  
**tog:** together  
**WS:** wrong side  
**wyib:** with yarn in back  
**wyif:** with yarn in front  
**yo:** yarn over  
**end on WS:** end having just completed a Wrong Side row.  
**end on RS:** end having just completed a Right Side row.  
**STOCKINETTE ST (St st):** Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**Reverse St st (Rev St st):** Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

**GARTER ST:** Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

**K1, p1 Rib:** Knit 1 st, purl 1 st.

**3 Needle Blind Off:** With RS together, hold in one hand two needles with the same number of sts on each. with third needle, knit tog 1 st from each needle, \*knit tog one st from each needle, pass first st over second to bind off, repeat from \*to last st.
